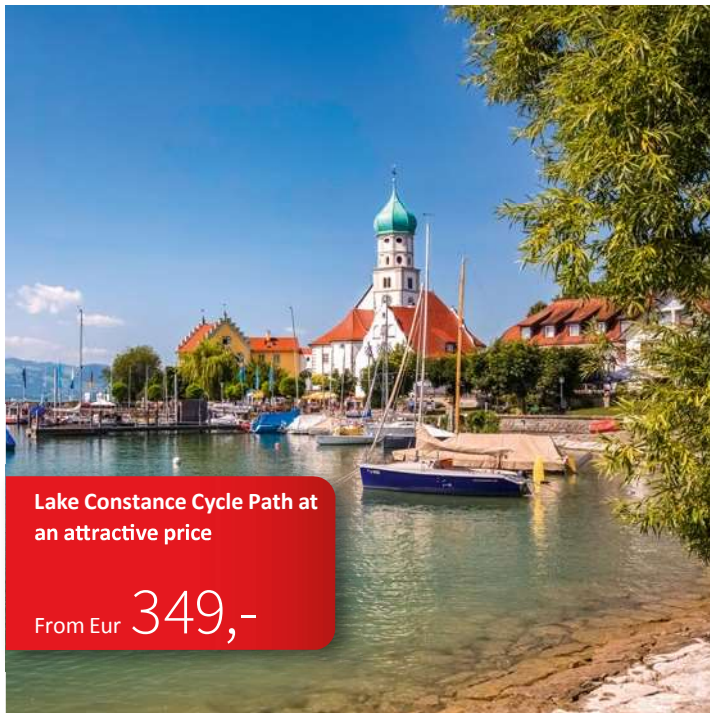

You cycle in four stages around the lake, get to know three countries and different landscapes. Look forward to the historic cities Constance, Stein am Rhein, Meersburg and Lindau as well as the festival town Bregenz.

Itinerary

Day 1	Individual arrival in Constance, cycle tour to Radolfzell, approx. 60 km		
Day 2	Radolfzell – Friedrichshafen, approx. 60 km		
Day 3	Friedrichshafen – Höchst, approx. 60 km		
Day 4	Höchst – Konstanz, approx. 55 km and individual departure without overnight stay

Journey to Konstanz

- Closest airport: Zurich, Stuttgart, Basel, Karlsruhe, Memmingen, Friedrichshafen
- Train station: Constance

Parking in Konstanz

- Fenced parking lot near the Radweg-Reisen office in Constance, must be booked and paid in advance.
- Parking garages (Fischmarkt, Dammgasse, Lago, Altstadt, Benediktinerplatz), costs approx. 25 Euro / day
- Hotel parking spaces (available in individual hotels, chargeable, details in the travel documents)

Bike handover

- Pick-up at Radweg-Reisen in Konstanz between 9 am and 7 pm, 7 days per week. On request delivery to the hotel, then no individual adjustment by our staff on site. Departure: Return at Radweg-Reisen or guests leave them at the hotel.

Luggage transport

- Luggage pick-up from 09.00 a.m., delivery to the next hotel by 06.00 p.m. at the latest, labeling of luggage is 1 x for the whole tour. No restriction on the number of pieces of luggage, but max. 20 kg per piece of luggage.

Travel documents

- 1 set (per booked room) consists of: hotel list and voucher, travel information with details on daily stages, short travel guides and route descriptions, maps, luggage tags
- Dispatched up to four weeks before arrival. For short-term bookings, delivery to the start hotel, hotel list and arrival information will be sent by email

Stages description

Day 1: Individual arrival in Constance, cycle tour to Radolfzell, approx. 60 km

Arrive in Constance by 10.00 a.m., drop off your luggage and get right on your bike.

Cycling along the southern bank of the lower lake, you pedal through picturesque Swiss fishing villages to Stein am Rhein with pretty frescoed medieval houses. From Stein am Rhein you cycle along the Hori peninsula, where Otto Dix and Hermann Hesse used to live and work. You are heading for today's destination, the former Imperial but now spa town of Radolfzell.

Day 2: Radolfzell – Friedrichshafen, approx. 60 km

From here, you cross the Bodanrück range of hills and encounter a very short incline. Arriving at the so-called Überlinger See, part of Lake Constance, you are rewarded for your efforts with beautiful views of the lake. Known here as the Swabian Sea. Enjoy a break in Überlingen and an ice cream on the pretty promenade. Today's destination,

Friedrichshafen, has a great Zeppelin Museum we can recommend visiting. It tells you everything there is to know about the history of these air ships.

Day 3: Friedrichshafen – Höchst, approx. 60 km

Today you cycle through extensive orchards, through Langenargen with its pretty Montfort Castle, built in the Moorish style. Shortly after you reach the Bavarian town of Lindau, whose harbour is watched over by a 6-metre high lion. The entire old town lies on an island. You should take the next break in Bregenz, the capital town of the Vorarlberg region of Austria, famous for its annual festival on the world's largest lake-stage.

Day 4: Höchst – Konstanz, approx. 55 km and individual departure without overnight stay

The last stage takes you through extensive orchards and pretty Swiss villages back to Constance. Again and again you will pass bathing spots. End your journey in Constance with an ice cream at the harbour. You will collect your luggage in the late afternoon (at the latest at 6.00 p.m.). Afterwards, you will depart on your own.
