## Your tour

You start in the old council city of Constance, cycle through medieval Stein am Rhein, take a trip to the thundering Rhine Falls near Schaffhausen, follow the shores of the Höri peninsula, climb the Bodanrück near Radolfzell, stroll along the Überlingen lakeside promenade and discover Germany's oldest inhabited castle in Meersburg. Via the Zeppelin city of Friedrichshafen, the tour takes you upbeat and with a view of the the Alps to the festival town of Bregenz and along the Swiss lakeshore back to along the Swiss lakeshore back to Constance.

- Train station: Constance

## Parking in Konstanz

- Fenced parking lot near the Radweg-Reisen office in Constance, must be booked and paid in advance.
- Parking garages (Fischmarkt, Dammgasse, Lago, Altstadt, Benediktinerplatz), costs approx. 25 Euro / day
- Hotel parking spaces (available in individual hotels, chargeable, details in the travel documents)

## Bike handover

- Pick-up at Radweg-Reisen in Konstanz between 9 am and 7 pm, 7 days per week. On request delivery to the hotel, then no individual adjustment by our staff on site. Departure: Return at Radweg-Reisen or guests leave them at the hotel.

## Luggage transport

- Luggage pick-up from 09.00 a.m., delivery to the next hotel by 06.00 p.m. at the latest, labeling of luggage is 1 x for the whole tour. No restriction on the number of pieces of luggage, but max. 20 kg per piece of luggage.

## Travel documents

→ 1 set (per booked room) consists of: hotel list and voucher, travel information with details on daily stages, short travel guides and route descriptions, maps, luggage tags

## Stages description

### Day 1: Individual arrival in Constance

Take the opportunity to visit the island of Mainau, wander through Constance's old town or visit the aquariums in the Sea Life Center and go to the Archaeological Museum.

### Day 2: Konstanz – Gailingen / Stein / Wangen, approx. 30 – 40 km

The first stage of your cycle tour takes you along the Swiss shore of Untersee to Stein am Rhein. The town has one of the most beautiful medieval town centres on Lake Constance and impresses with its colourfully painted facades. A few kilometres downstream you will reach Gailingen, Stein am Rhein or cycle to the picturesque Höri peninsula to Wangen or Hemmenhofen. The painter Otto Dix once lived in Hemmenhofen and the writer Hermann Hesse in Gaienhofen.

### Day 3: Day trip to the Rhine Falls, approx. 20 / 40 km + boat trips

Switching between Germany and Switzerland several times, you reach the cantonal capital of Schaffhausen, overlooked by the Munot fortress, whose citizens competed in building bay windows. After a few kilometres you reach the Rhine Falls, one of the largest waterfalls in Europe. Head up the Rhine by boat back to Gailingen. From the water, you will experience the river landscape of the High Rhine in a very special way.

### Day 4: Gailingen – Radolfzell, approx. 35 / 25 km

From Gailingen you cycle back through Stein am Rhein and along the Höri peninsula, where Otto Dix and Hermann Hesse used to live and work. You are heading for today's destination, the former Imperial but now spa town of Radolfzell.

### Day 5: Radolfzell – Überlingen / Uhdlingen, approx. 25 / 35 km

You cross the Bodanrück, which divides the north-western part of Lake Constance into Lake Überlingen and Untersee. There are some impressive views of the surroundings here. For cycling, it is sometimes a little strenuous. You can catch your breath in Sipplingen. The small town with its historic centre has a very special character. It's a wonderful place to walk and swim. In Überlingen you can relax in the thermal baths. Stroll through the listed town garden and enjoy the Mediterranean flair.

### Day 6: Überlingen – Friedrichshafen, approx. 25 / 35 km

The Lake Constance Cycle Route takes you along the upper lake to Unteruhldingen, where you should visit the pile dwellings. The next destination on the stage is Meersburg with its beautiful old town and old castle. It towers stately over Lake Constance. Take a break in the historical atmosphere before continuing to Friedrichshafen. Visit the Dornier Museum or the Zeppelin Museum. From the 22-metre-high observation tower on the harbour pier, you can enjoy a beautiful view of the Alpine panorama.

### Day 7: Friedrichshafen – Lindau / Bregenz, approx. 25 / 35 km

Next, you cycle through extensive orchards, through Langenargen with its pretty Montfort Castle, built in the Moorish style. Shortly after you reach the Bavarian town of Lindau, whose harbour is watched over by a 6-metre high lion. The entire old town lies on an island.

### Day 8: Lindau – Rorschach / Arbon / Horn, approx. 30 – 50 km

Continuing on your way, you reach Bregenz, the capital of the Vorarlberg region of Austria and famous for its annual festival on the largest lake-stage in the world. You finally reach Höchst where you soon cross the border again and then, after pedaling onwards for a few kilometres, reach Rorschach or Arbon.

### Day 9: Rorschach – Constance, approx. 30 – 50 km

The last day of your tour takes you through Romanshorn which is home to Switzerland's largest harbour on Lake Constance. Now you continue on along the banks of Lake Constance back to Constance. This stretch is flat and easy to cycle, unless in a stronger westerly wind. You will frequently pass places where you can go swimming and refresh yourself in the lovely cool waters of the lake. Let your tour come to a pleasant end with a wander through the old town or an ice cream down at the harbour.

### Day 10: Individual departure

After breakfast you start your individual return journey home or extend your stay.
